Qualified Domestic Relations Order (QDRO)

While many aspects of a divorce can be resolved relatively easily during the proceedings, reallocating retirement benefits is a notoriously complex task. A Qualified Domestic Relations Order (aka 'QDRO') is the specific type of court order that allows a retirement account administrator to divide a retirement account (one that is qualified under the IRS Code as a retirement account) between divorcing spouses. Most cases that involve QDROs involve a third party Attorney to draft the QDRO to ensure that it meets statutory requirements and is satisfactory for the account administrator and the Court.
